Quick Math Addition



You and your partner will each reveal a certain number of fingers to each other. The first person to add them together first wins the round.

- Stand up and find a partner. A group of three works as well.
- Face your partner and put both hands behind your back.
- Each person chooses from one to ten fingers with his/her hands.
- 4. Both persons say, "One, two, three QUICKMATH." When the word "QUICKMATH" is said, each person moves his/her hands in front of him/herself at the same time displaying their chosen number with their fingers.
- The person who adds the numbers together and says the total correctly first is the winner of that round.
- 6. Play the best of five rounds.
